- 2) Apply for your **Degree and Diploma application (DDA)** online by the end of your last quarter.
- 3) Find Commencement Ceremony Information here. (PLEASE NOTE: Commencement and graduation are not the same! To graduate, you need to officially file a DDA)
- 4) Rent your Cap and Gown and get your Commencement Ticket at the Bookstore starting early *June*.
