How Much Does it Cost to Attend?

[Fees for 2016-2017](#) were \$15,822.87 per year for residents and \$42,804.87 for non-residents. Fees for 2017-2018 are yet to be determined. An optional deferred payment plan, [TRIP](#), spreads payments over the quarter.

What About Financial Aid?

The [Financial Aid Office](#) will prepare and send you a Preliminary Award Notification by late March if you have met all application deadlines. A more precise offer will be mailed starting in May, once your financial aid file is complete.

What About Housing?

On-Campus Transfer Housing is available at The Village. The Village is a community of apartments and retail spaces designed especially for transfer students. The neighborhood consists of Village West and Village East, a total of 13 buildings, two of which are high rises with incredible ocean views. All of the resident apartment homes feature modern amenities and a sleek design aesthetic. The best part? A prime location - right on campus!
