#### COMPARATIVE PERSPECTIVES

This course will focus on the experiences and organizing efforts of women in different parts of the world. In our analyses of testimonials, essays, novels, and films, we will emphasize cultural differences, but we will also attempt to forge, from points of commonality, a global perspective. Our studies will include: the Argentinian Madres of the Plaza de Mayo; Gabriela, a mass organization of diverse women's groups in the Philippines; the Hawaiian political sovereignty movement; the efforts of Palestinian and Israeli peace activists to work together; and issues of global feminist identity as they are brought home to us in the United States.
