# UC San Diego Muir College <br> General Education Requirements <br> Effective Fall 2021 

In order to graduate, all Muir College students must meet the requirements of the university, their major, and Muir College. Below are Muir General Education requirements for first year students entering Fall 2021 and later.

## Muir Writing

O MCWP 40 and MCWP 50
All students are required to take Muir College Writing. First-pass enrollment priority will be given to students during their first six quarters (and to transfer students during their first three quarters per required course) at UCSD. All other Muir students will be eligible to enroll during the second-pass enrollment period.
