Muir College's Commuter Student Guide

1. Commuting to Campus:

- a. Triton Transit Triton Transit operates fare-free on- and off-campus services
 - i. **Shuttles** Fixed-route service between campus shuttle stops
 - 1. Provides free transportation on campus and to select off-campus locations. View a live map of the shuttle routes and stops on the <u>Live Shuttle Tracker</u>
 - ii. **Mobility** Door-to-door service for individuals with limited mobility
 - iii. On Demand On-Demand service between existing Triton Transit stops during evening hours and academic breaks when fixed route service is reduced or suspended.
 - 1. Rides may be requested through the <u>TransLoc app.</u>
 - 2. On-Demand coordinates closely with the UC San Diego Police <u>Community Service Officer program</u>, (858) 534-9255, which can provide safety escorts on campus between sunset and sunrise.

iv. For real-time updates:

- 1. For Triton Transit service updates, subscribe to First to Know.
- 2. Download the <u>TransLoc app</u> for real-time shuttle locations and alerts.
- 3. Receive texts about detours, delays and service changes by subscribing to Transit Alerts through the university's Everbridge platform. Text "ucsdtransit" to 888777.
- b. Public Transit Bus, Trolley, & Train
 - i. Transit products for the <u>San Diego Metropolitan Transit System</u> (MTS) and <u>North County Transit District</u> (NCTD) are delivered through the <u>PRONTO</u> regional fare system.
 - 1. <u>U-Pass</u> included in your student fees, students are able to use U-Pass during the **fall, winter and spring** academic guarters
 - a. <u>PRONTO App</u> UC San Diego currently enrolled students are uploaded to the PRONTO portal. Each student is required to create a PRONTO account and link to the U-Pass program.
 - b. **PRONTO cards** are available for students who do not have access to use the PRONTO U-Pass app with a smartphone
 - c. Please note, you are not allowed to have both PRONTO app pass and physical PRONTO card active at the same time; you must choose one fare media
 - 2. <u>Triton Summer U-Pass</u> \$67.60 for eligible students

- c. Parking Parking Payment Required 7 Days a Week
 - i. Parking Permits
 - ii. Parking Availability

- iii. <u>Flexible Parking:</u> Pay for parking just those times when you need to park!
 - 1. Use ParkMobile to purchase parking passes daily for A, B, S and D
 - 2. You can either call ParkMobile at (877) 727-5932 or purchase a daily permit through the UC San Diego <u>parking portal.</u>

d. Ridesharing:

- i. <u>Carpools and Vanpools</u> for two or more faculty, staff and student registered commuters
 - 1. Use UC San Diego's <u>Triton Commuter Club</u> or personal networking to find other UC San Diego faculty, staff and students who want to carpool!
- ii. <u>Passenger Loading Zones</u> preferred pickup/drop-off and restricted locations

e. Other Alternatives:

- i. Shared Bikes & Scooters
 - 1. Approximately 200 bikes and 800 scooters are available in key campus locations
 - 2. Spin hubs are located at North Point Loop, Tata Hall, Marshall College, Center Hall, Sixth College, Seventh College, Pepper Canyon and Muir College.
 - 3. Spin Promos & Rates:
 - New student riders: Use code TRITON5 to get \$5 off when you create an account with an "ucsd.edu" email address.
 Prices for users with an @ucsd.edu (or subdomain) email address:
 - b. E-bikes and e-scooters: \$1 to unlock and \$0.24 per minute to ride
 - 4. Spin Access
 - a. If you received a Pell Grant or participate in CalFresh, you qualify for <u>Spin Access</u>. Participants in other need-based programs may also qualify. Unlock a bike or scooter for just \$.50 and ride for only \$.10/minute—a more than 50% discount from UC San Diego's already reduced rates. <u>Enroll today</u>!
 - 5. Unlock Pass for Just \$3/Month
 - a. If you're planning to be a regular rider, a 30-day unlock pass for just \$3/month can save you a boatload. Ride as many times as you want for 30 days and you'll never pay an unlock fee. If that's not enough, you'll get 10% off ride

time too. Look for "Spin Pass" in the Spin app menu. This special deal will only be visible when on campus.

- 6. Fall Quarter Pass
 - a. Purchase the new 120-day Fall Quarter Pass and spend less than \$2 per trip. For more information on this pass and others, check out "Spin Pass" in the menu of the Spin app.

 - 3. To sign up for notifications, simply log in to the UC San Diego app, go to "Settings," tap "Notifications," and turn the free food notification on!
